Saraiva's current research involves using cutting-edge technologies to identify biomarkers and develop potential approaches to treat human disorders affecting the sense of smell.

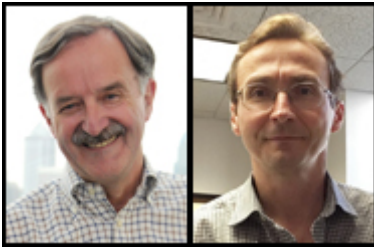
